

Getting started in the Unix (Xubuntu) Environment.

Our first computer based exercise is to help you get familiar with the working environment that we will use this semester.

Your Tasks:

1. Carefully read the handout entitled “Programming and Development Environment”.
2. Follow the directions and install **X2Go** on your computer.
3. Use your account name and password (given in class), connect to gottlieb.cs.wfu.edu using your newly installed **X2Go** client software. No need to do much on gottlieb at this point, just make sure you can connect (fullscreen) and can logout.
4. Read the Unix tutorial. See the web page:

5. As you work through each section, you are encouraged to log on to gottlieb.cs.wfu.edu and try some examples. At the end of most sections, there is a quiz. On gottlieb.cs.wfu.edu, use the text editor **emacs** to write your answers to each question in the quiz. The last section (section seven) does not have a quiz.

Save your written answers in a text file named **answers.txt**. Be sure to include your name at the beginning of the file.

6. When you have worked through all tutorial sections, upload your answers to your account on **telesto**. Recall there is a section on how to upload files in Unix Tutorial #2.
