

## Using TightVNC with Linux (or Macintosh)

To use TightVNC remote desktop using server gottlieb, and your Linux laptop:

### Step 1:

- Point your browser to: <http://www.tightvnc.com/download.php>
- Download the TightVNC Java client.
- Unzip / uncompress the download. You should have a file named `tightvnc-jviewer.jar`

### Step 2:

- Move the file `tightvnc-jviewer.jar` to your `bin` directory.
- Make sure your `bin` directory is in your `PATH` on your local machine.

### Step 3:

- Create an executable shell script named `gott` (or any other name of your choice) with the following contents:

```
#!/bin/sh
java -jar /home/USERNAME/bin/tightvnc-jviewer.jar -port=XXXX gottlieb.cs.wfu.edu
```

Remember to substitute your user name on gottlieb for "USERNAME". Remember to substitute your port number on gottlieb for "XXXX".

### Step 4:

- Put your shell script in your `bin` directory.
- Make sure it is executable (use `chmod u+x gott`).

### Step 5:

- Try it. Type the name of your shell script, and it should connect you to `gottlieb.cs.wfu.edu`.
